



GLOBAL ECOLOGY ANNOUNCES EPA FILING.

Montclair, NJ April 6, 2011. Global Ecology Corporation (“GEC”), Symbol; GLEC: OTCQB, announced today that it has completed the first and lengthiest phase for EPA approval for its licensed, proprietary formula, IMS1000™. Upon final approval by the EPA, GEC will be granted exclusive distributorship for the United States by the manufacturer, EnvirEau of Canada.

This preliminary process will identify the product applications that will be granted. This requires meetings with EPA representatives and back up efficacy data that will determine the various uses to be approved. The EPA registration for IMS1000™ will cover:

- Potable water reservoirs and tanks
- Cooling towers and HVAC systems
- Irrigation reservoirs, ponds & lakes
- Irrigation conveyance systems
- Sprinkler, drip, Injection or other types of irrigation equipment
- Chemigation systems
- Impounded waters, lakes, ponds and reservoirs
- Aquaculture Ponds
- Biological Fish Ponds
- Water features and fountains etc.
- Foliar spray for ag/hort applications (greenhouses, plantations, etc)
- Shelf-life extension for post-harvested fruit, vegetables and poultry/fish.

As a result of this substantial progress, GEC has made arrangements for the field testing of the IMS1000™ in HVAC systems. Laboratory tests to date have shown very favorable results for this application and once these field tests confirm the lab results, we will be ready to begin discussions with distributors and end users.

“Although it is difficult to predict the exact date the EPA will complete their process, we have determined that the list of approved uses will more than outweigh the time required for their approval.
